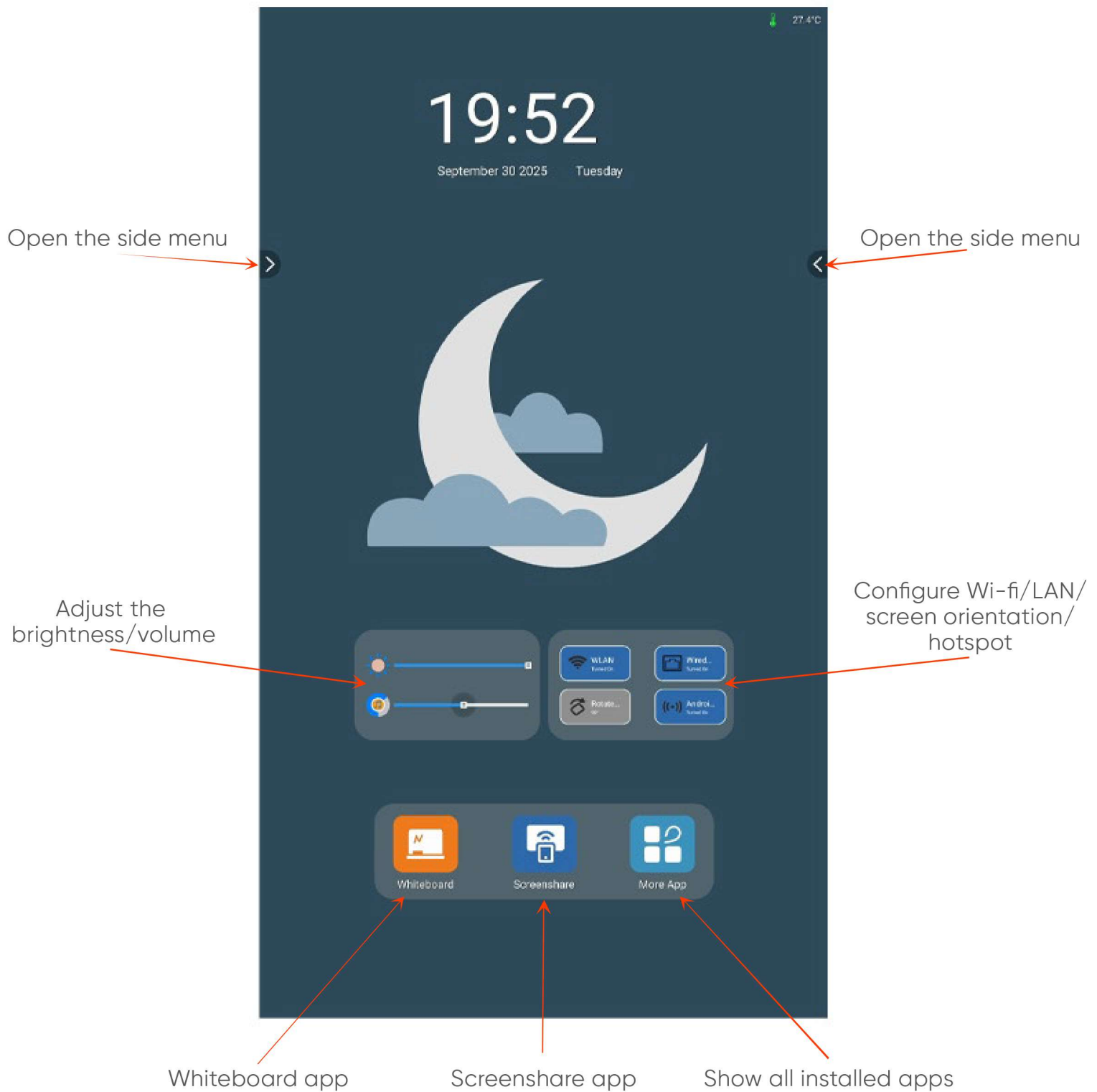

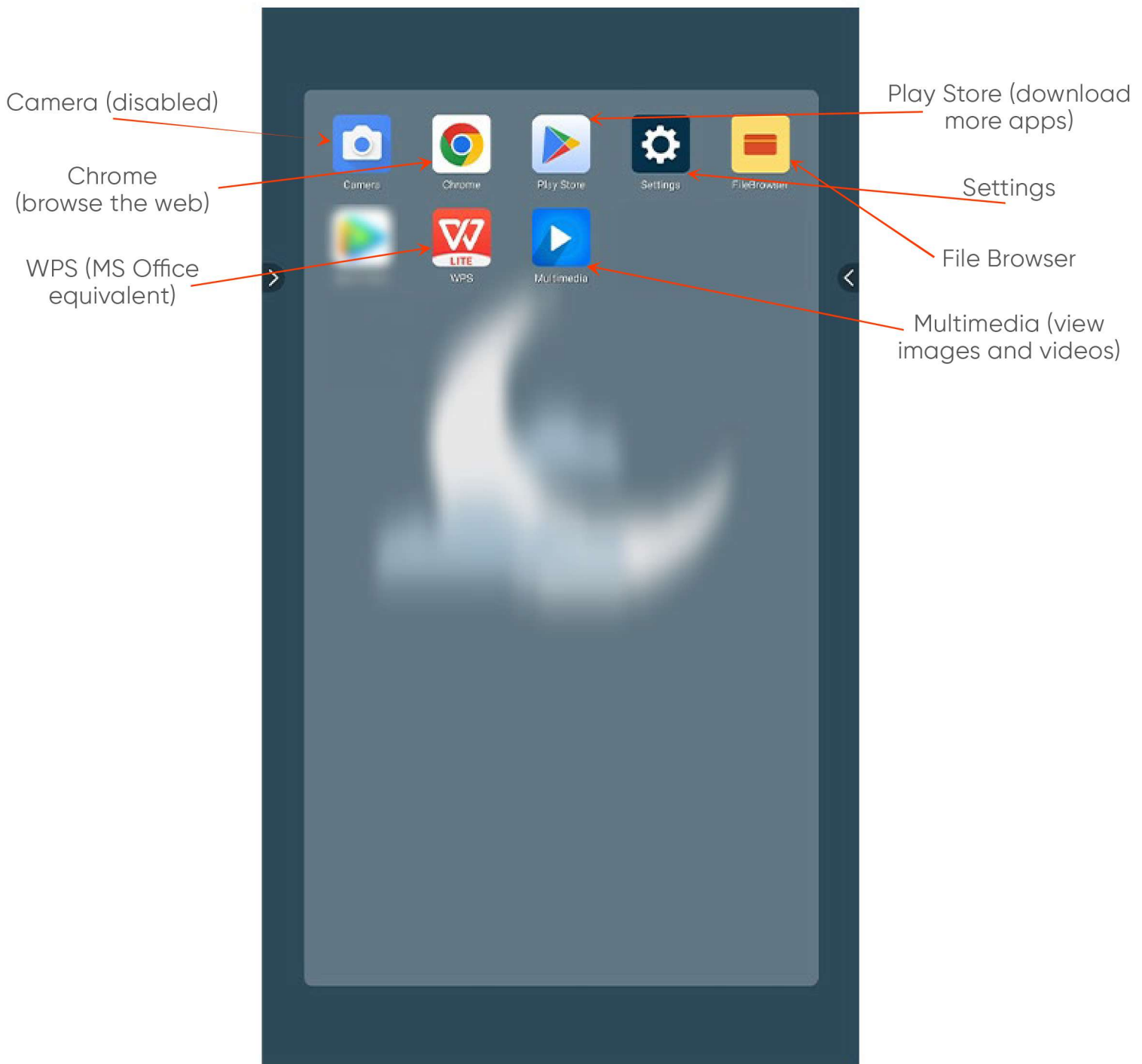
Home Screen

All apps

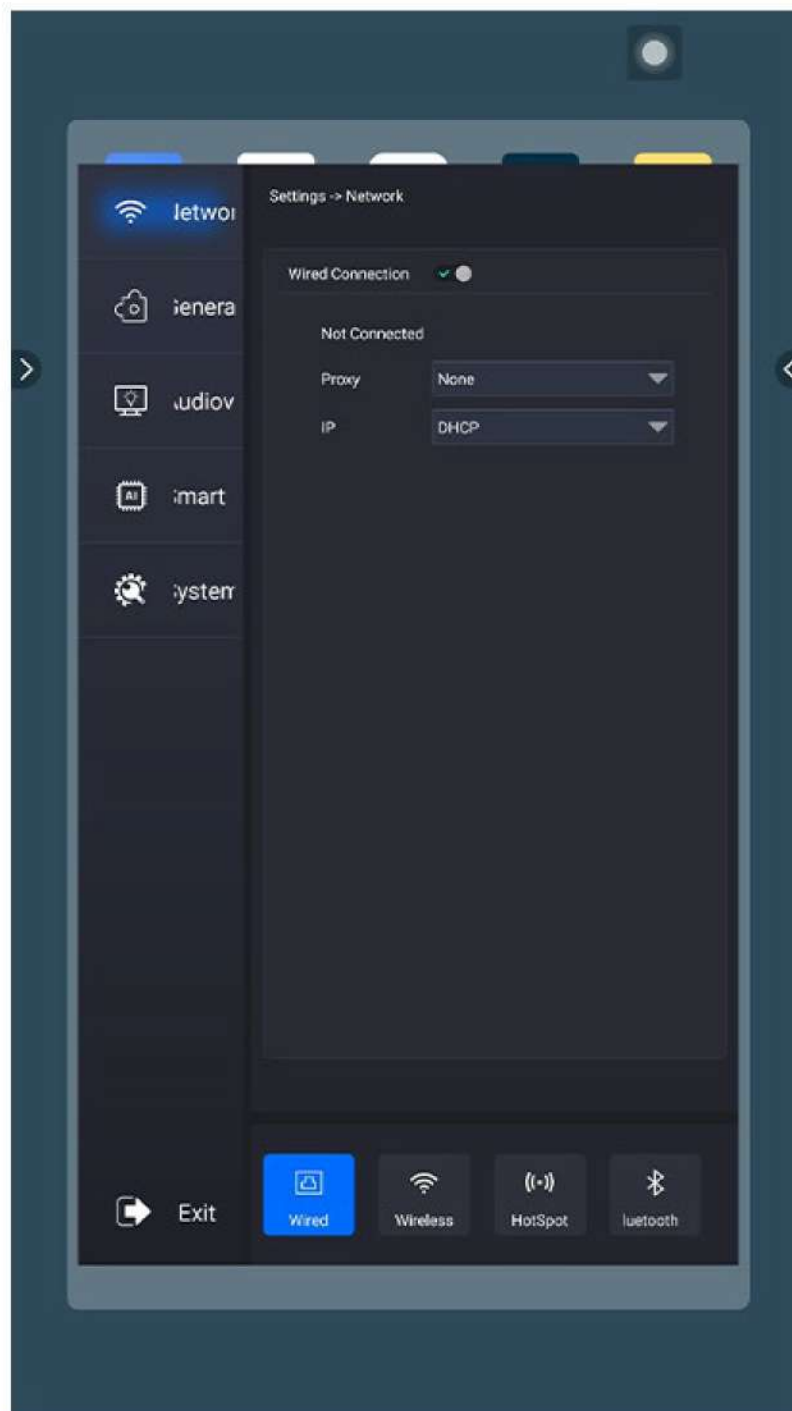
After tapping "More app" you will be taken to this screen, pictured below.

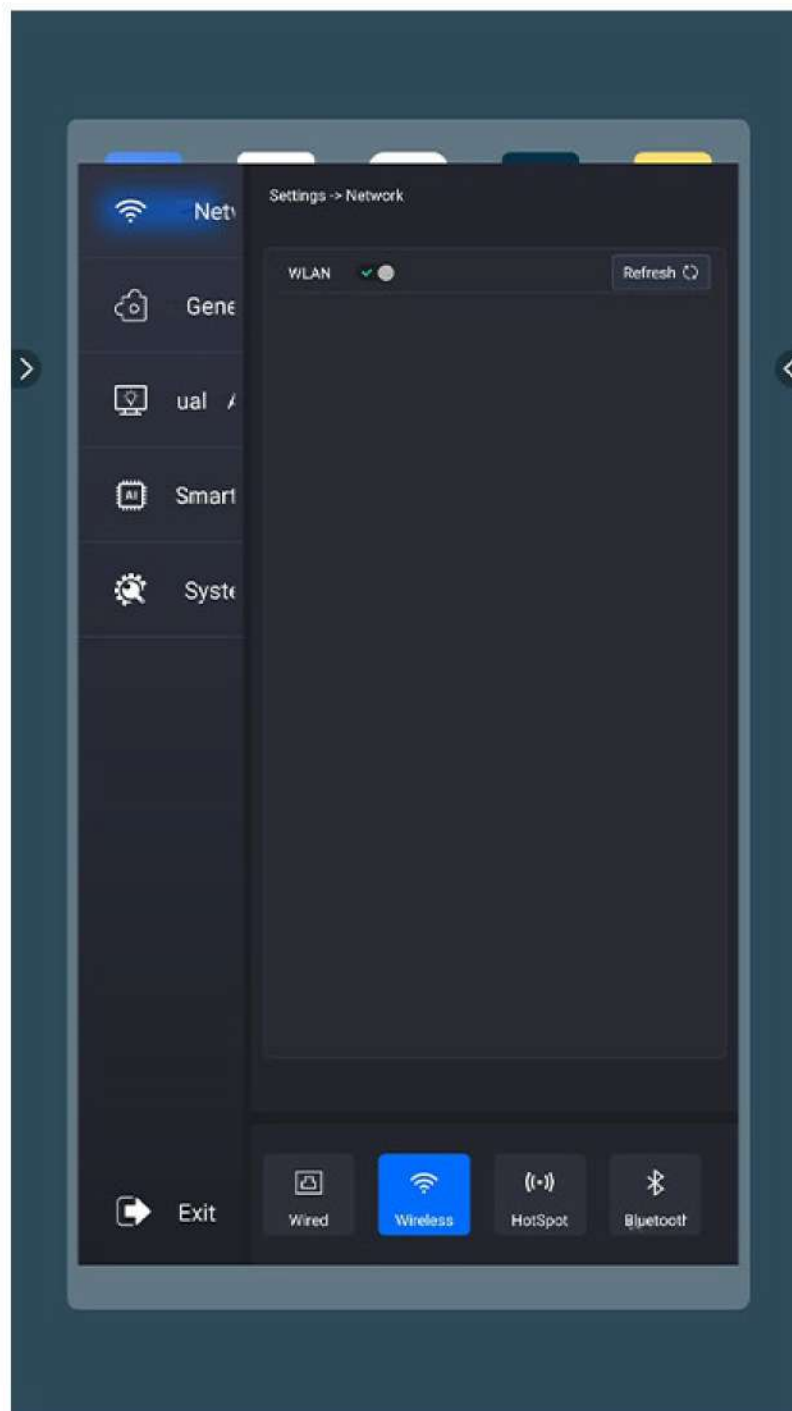
Select 'Wired' to configure a wired connection to the screen. NOTE: The wired internet cable must be plugged in to the port on the right on the back of the screen.

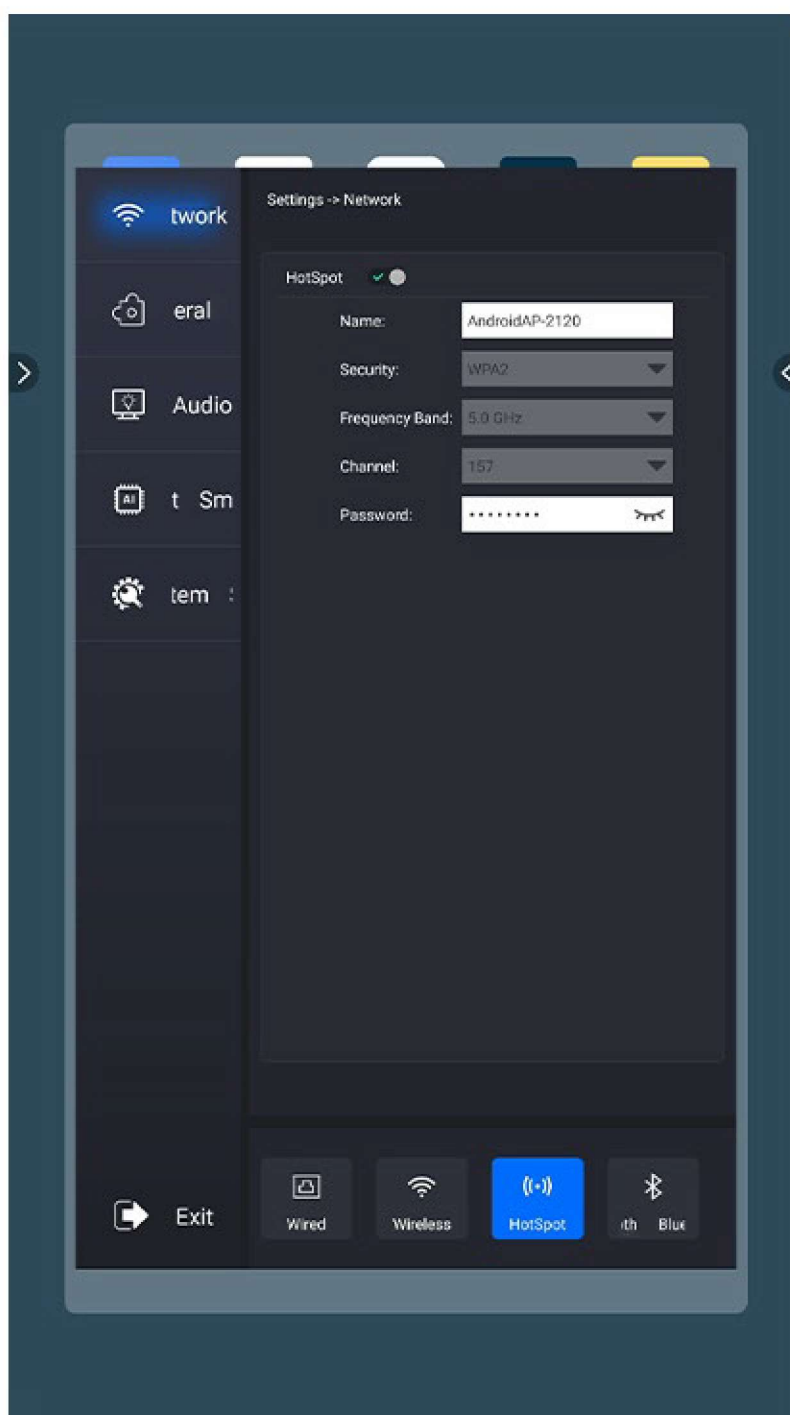
Select 'Wireless' to configure a wireless connection to the screen. NOTE: The antennas must be plugged in to the back of the screen.

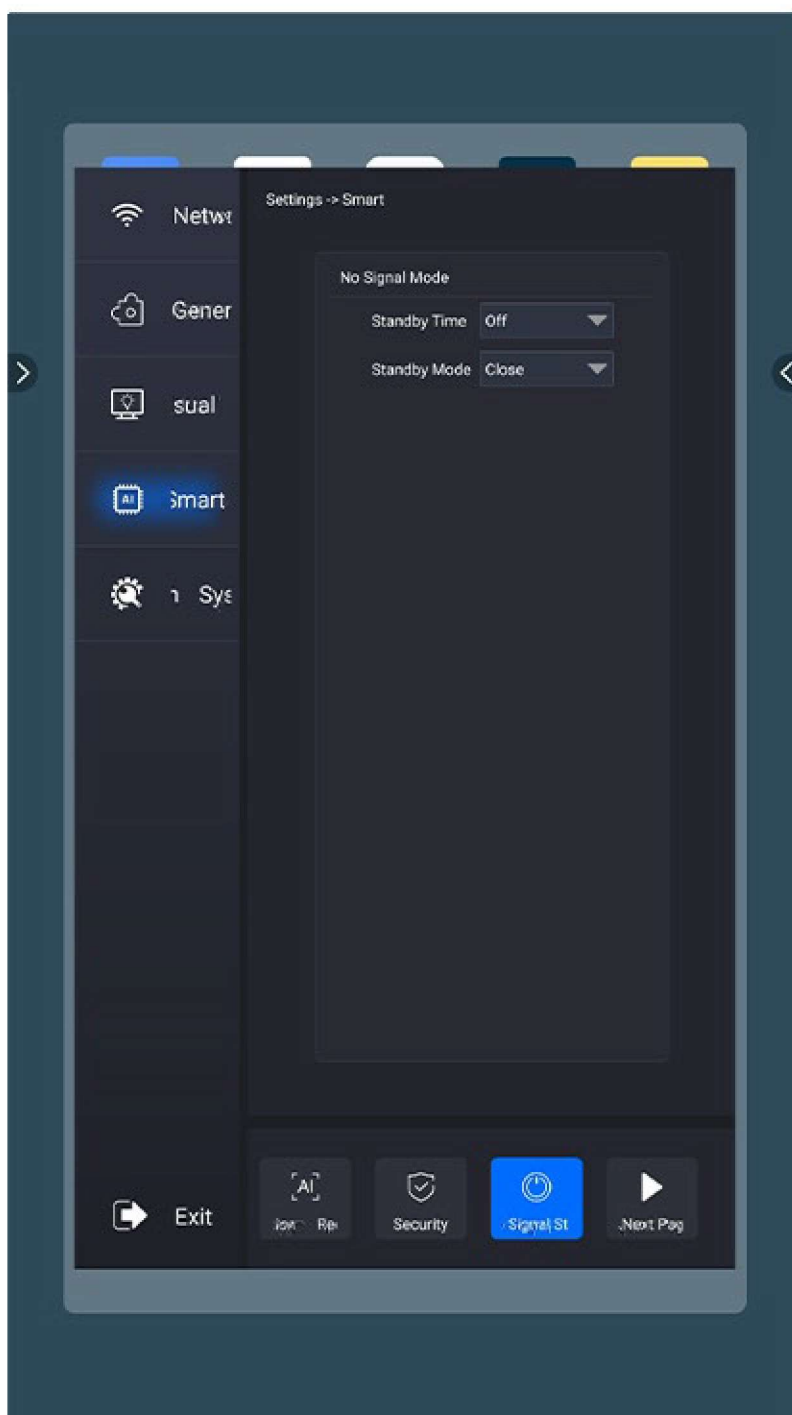

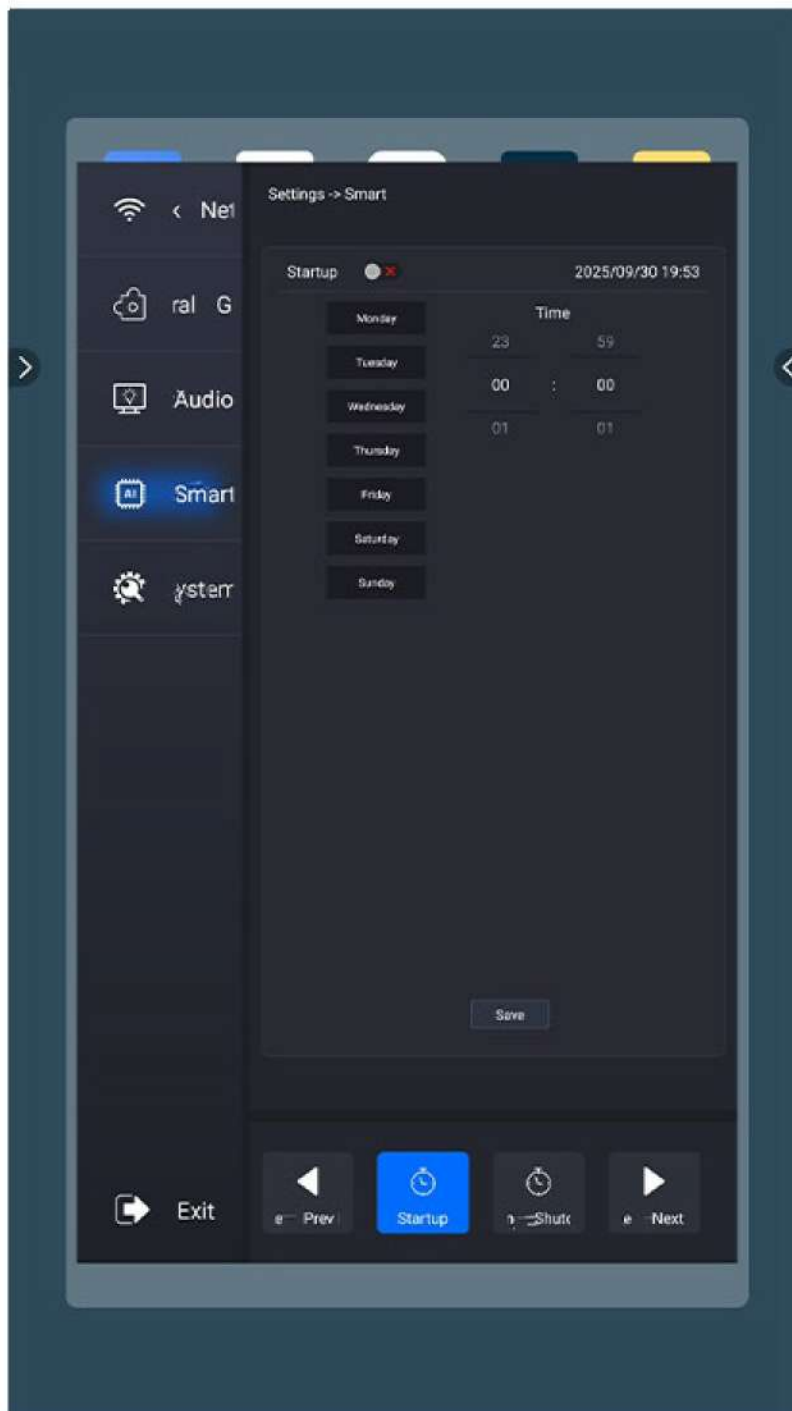

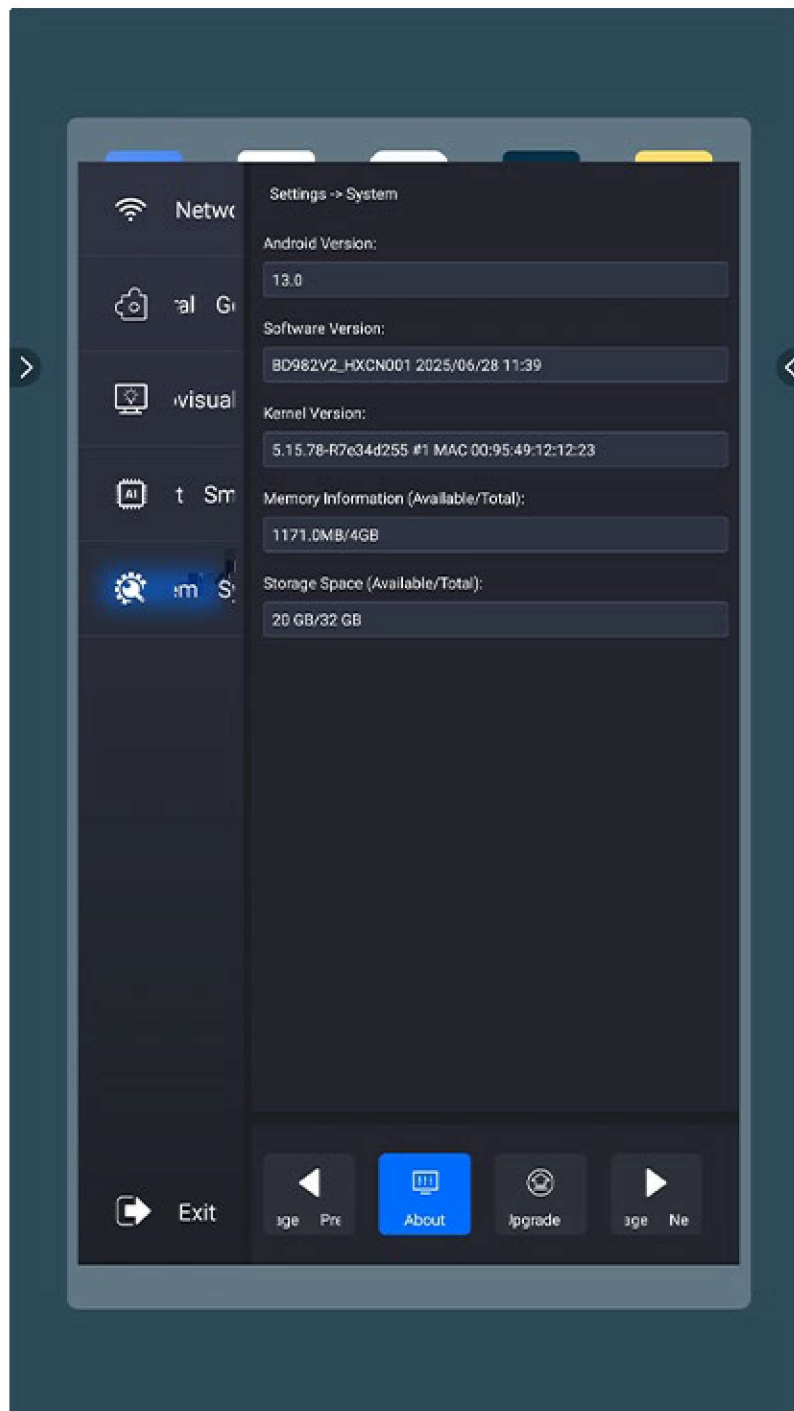
Select 'Boot-up play' to toggle video autoplay on boot. You will need to place the video into the AutoPlay folder within the File Explorer app.

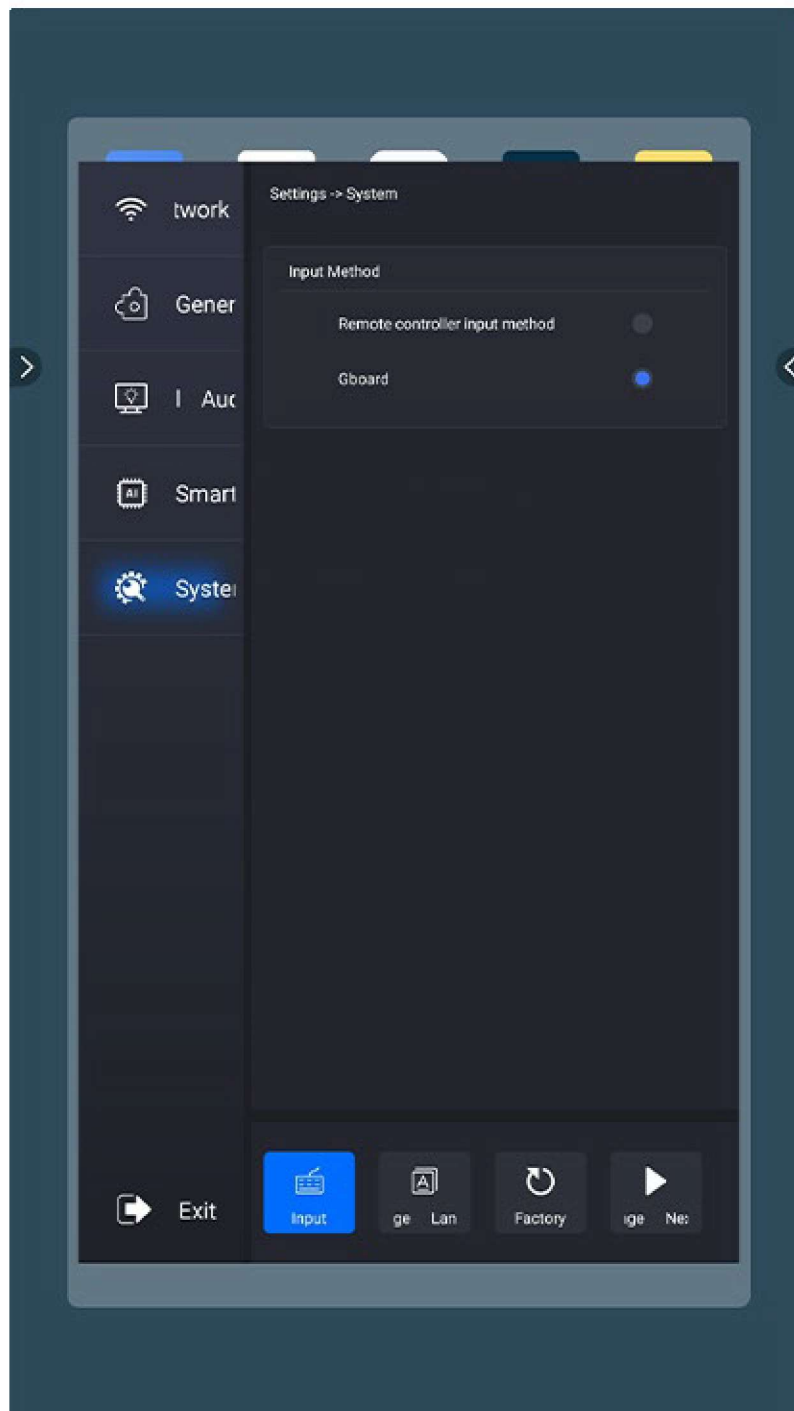
Select 'About' to view device information.

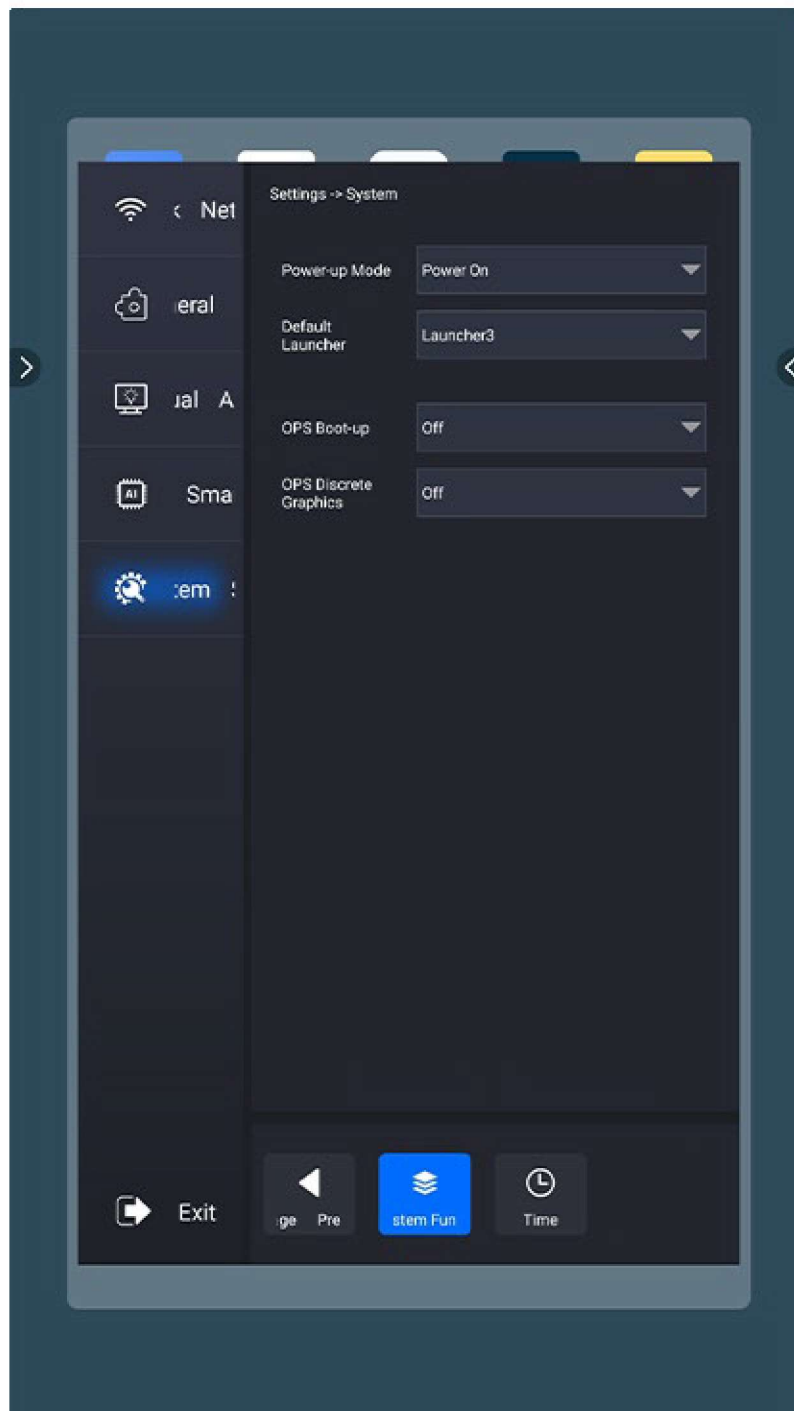
Select 'Input' to switch between an on screen keyboard and the remote controller..

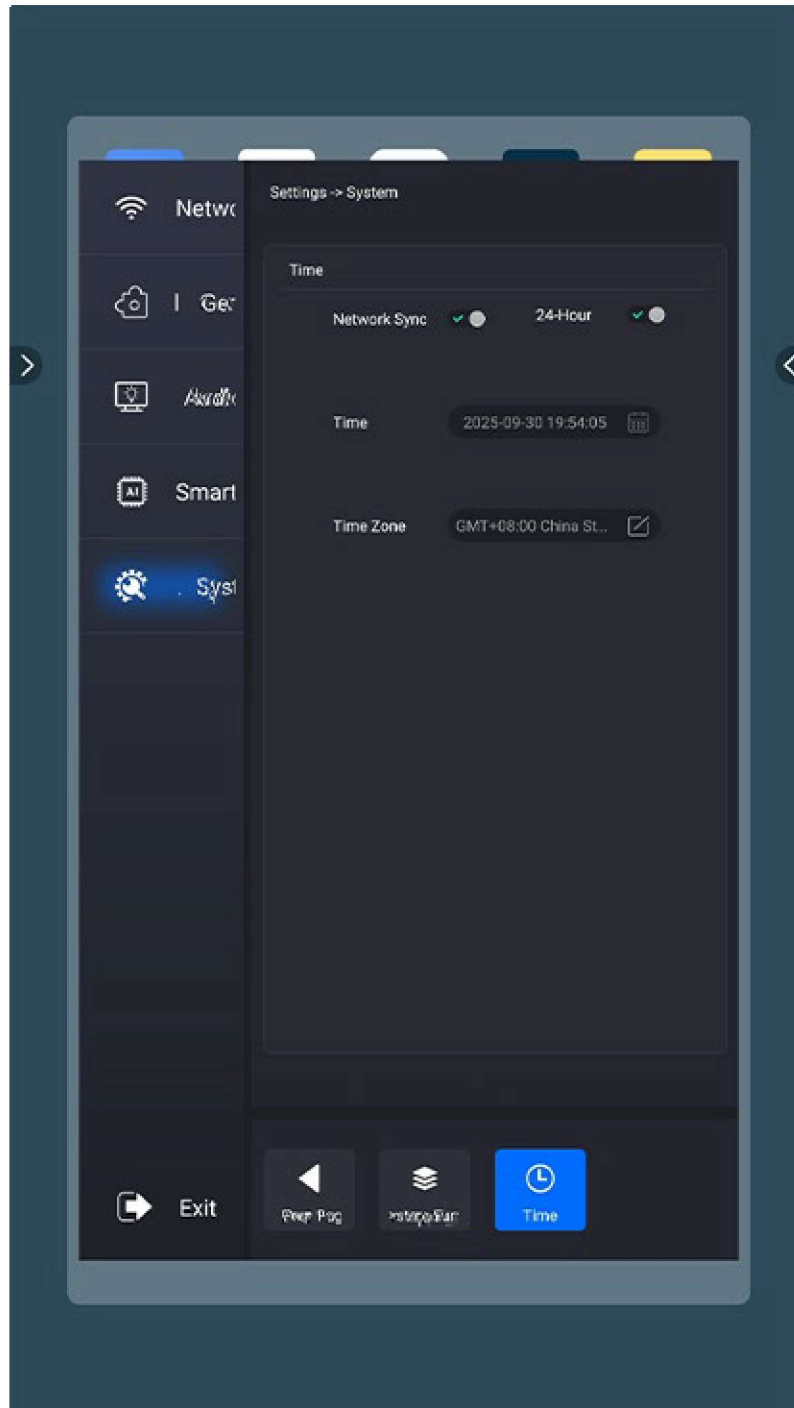
Select 'System Functions' to change the power-up mode, and change the OPS PC auto-boot settings.

Select 'Time' to change the date, time and time zone.



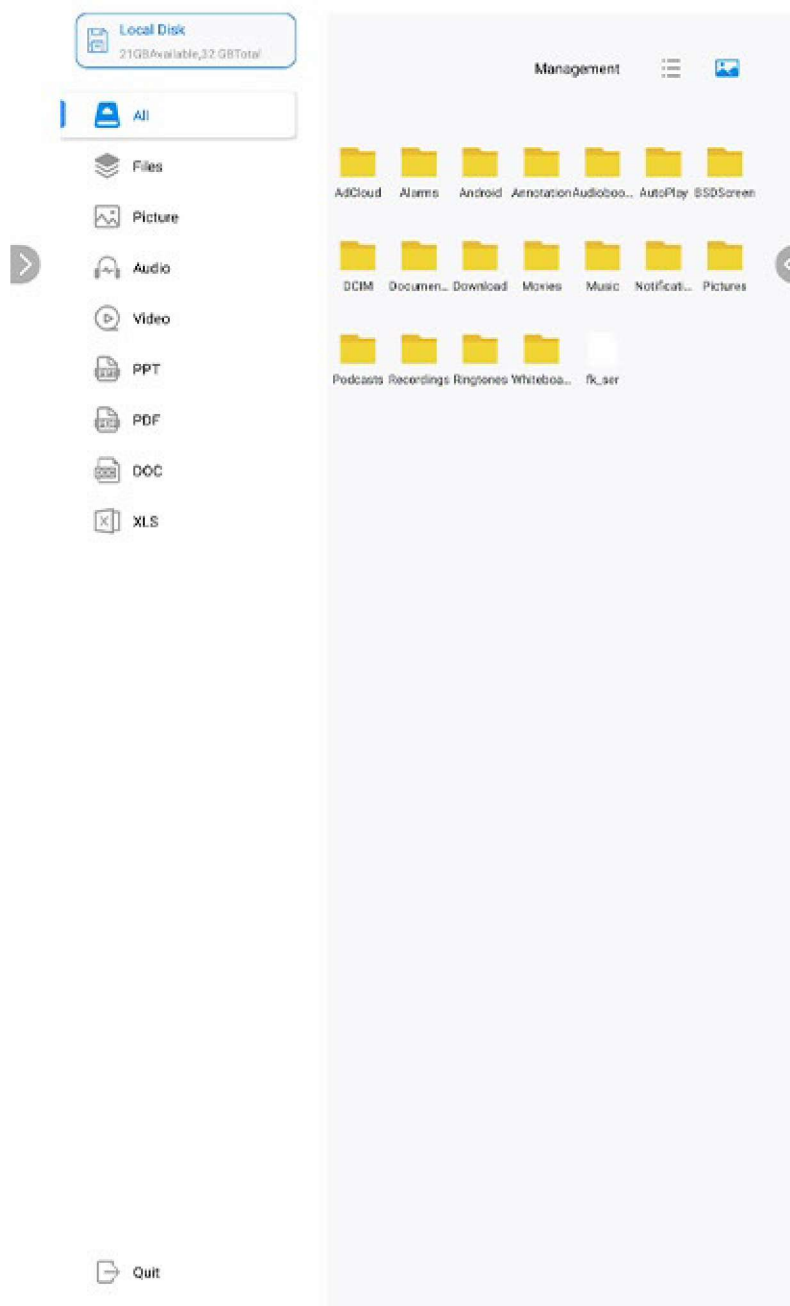
File Explorer - Overview

Tapping "File Explorer" will take you to this menu. In the column on the left, you will see different file types, as well as 'all'. Tap on a row to navigate to its contents.

NOTE: Putting a video in the "AutoPlay" folder and then toggling on AutoPlay will cause the totem to only play that video.

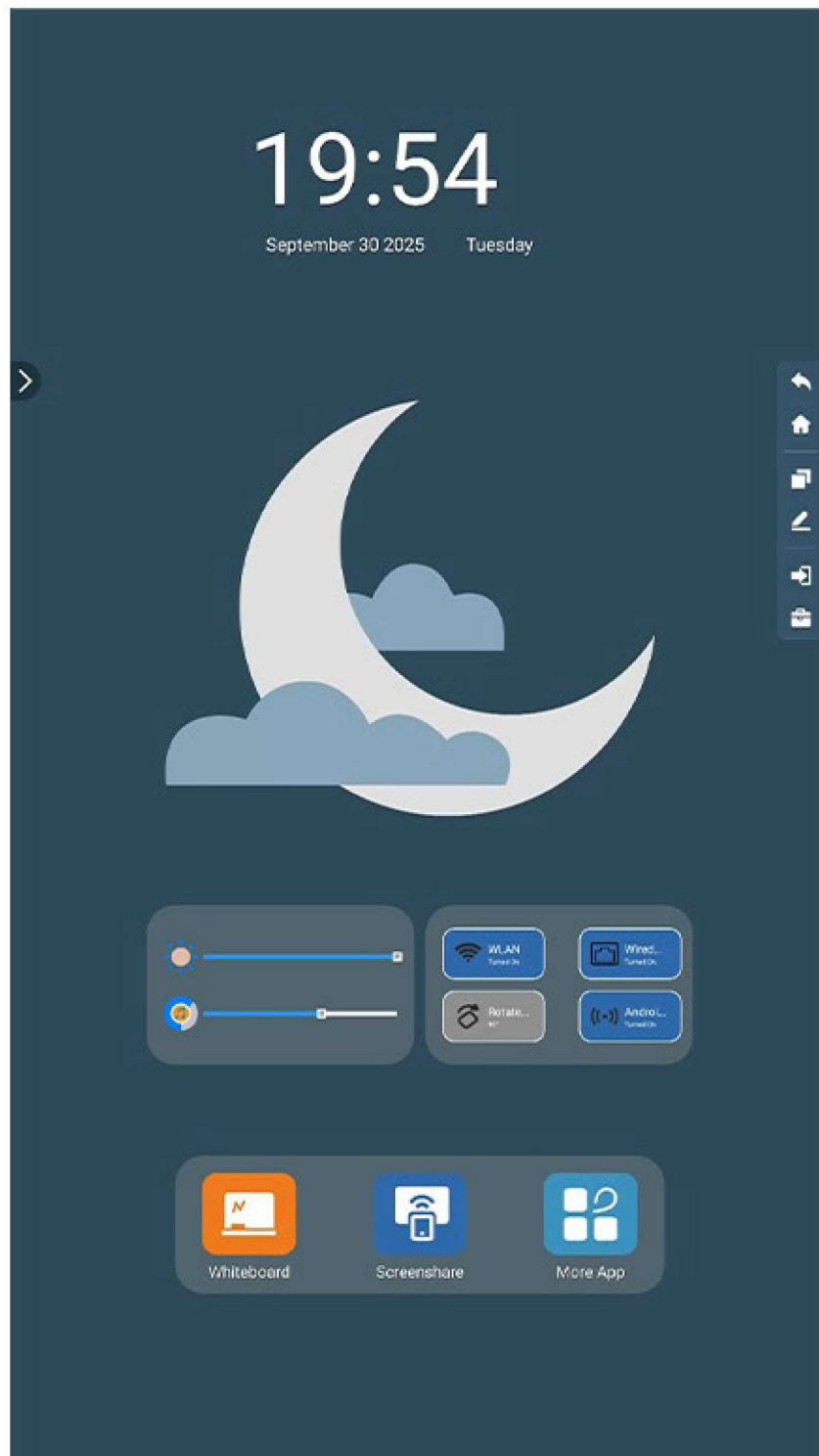
NOTE: If inserting a USB stick, ensure it is in one of the two USB ports on the back of the totem to the right. This will then appear underneath "Local Disk".

Hold on a file to access the different options.



Side Menu

Tapping one of the arrows on either side of the screen will bring up this menu. This can be hidden within the settings menu (Settings > General > More).

Advanced Side Menu

Tapping on the briefcase icon on the simple side menu will bring up this advanced side menu. From here, you can choose two apps to split screen, add a child lock, turn the screen off, take a screenshot, start a screen recording, magnify a section of the screen, set a timer, access the camera (disabled for this totem), and add more apps to this section. You can also adjust the brightness and volume from here, turn the totem off, switch to PC, and access the settings menu.

NOTE: The default password for the childlock is 2580 or 0000.
